### QUALIFICATIONS (Education and Experience)

- Be enrolled as a second year student in a Masters Program, either in Social Work, Psychology, Counseling Psychology or Mental Health Counseling.
- OR
- Be enrolled (at a minimum) as a first year student in a Ph.D. or Psy.D. doctoral program in Clinical Psychology or Counseling Psychology.
- Computer skills, including proficiency in Word and Excel.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Ability to promote a caring and respectful attitude toward service recipients, staff and other volunteers and interns, respecting privacy and confidentiality.
- Be consistent in attendance.
- Attend required training.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Attend clinical supervision with on-site advisor.
- Maintain and follow agency policies.
- Reliable transportation.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Proof of Current Auto Insurance.

## **PRINCIPLE ACCOUNTABILITIES**

### **General Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Be a role model for service recipients.
- Sensitivity to service recipients' ethnic, cultural and economic backgrounds, as well as physical or mental challenges.

- Attend internal and external trainings as required.

- Conduct clinical assessments
- Conduct individual, group and family therapy
- Develop treatment plans
- Participate in discharge planning

## **OTHER RELATED RESPONSIBILITIES**

All interns complete an intake and orientation that includes the opportunity to interview other interns, Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) clearance, reference check, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) training, Mantoux (tuberculosis) screening (at some programs), information on Community Care Services' mission, as well as the program's place in that mission, including its philosophy, goals and general policies. We will arrange for all of these requirements.

Interns are invited and encouraged to attend additional training, including First Aid, CPR, CPI - Day 1 (De-escalation), Compliance and Performance Quality Improvement.

## **WORKING CONDITIONS**

A dedicated working space for interns is provided at the internship site (70 Main Street, Taunton, MA 02780 or 140 Park Street, Attleboro, MA 02703).

We have over 400 employees and 250 volunteers, including interns. Staff having the privilege of supervising interns is challenged to learn and teach. Students introduce new skills and fresh ideas; and bring out the best in us.
